

# Erasmus + Exchange Program Competition for BSU Faculty of Technology undergraduate students at Valencia University of Technology

A competition is announced for students of the Faculty of Technology of BSU to win a scholarship at the University of Technology of Valencia (Spain) within the framework of the Erasmus + exchange program funded by the European Commission. The competition is open to students who have successfully passed the Institutional Test in English on September 16, 2021 (see results) or are an International Foreign Language Certificate .

## **Terms of participation in the competition :**

The student must have an active status at BSU:

- Undergraduate level III, IV, V or VI semester student;
- Must not have received an Erasmus Mundus / Erasmus + grant at a similar level;
- Must not have spent more than 12 months in the last 5 years in an EU country;
- The candidate submits an application for the level at which he / she is admitted during the competition;
- In order to participate in the competition, it is necessary for the candidate to study in the program offered by the mentioned universities and / or to pass the relevant subjects in this field (including the MINOR program).

## **Matching subjects is one of the main conditions of the competition !**

Stages of the competition:

### **Stage I :**

**2021 On 22 September 28 September (18:00 pm )** - established by the document through the electronic link <https://registration.bsu.ge/Registration-2.php> and the Department of e-mail [erasmus@bsu.edu.ge](mailto:erasmus@bsu.edu.ge)

### **Phase II :**

**September 29 , 2021** - Interview with the Qualification Commission.

*Note documents performance in both address is required!*

### **Documents to be submitted:**

- Copy of ID card / international passport;
- Certificate of student status (in Georgian);
- Europass CV (in English);
- Motivation letter no more than 1 page (in English);
- Mark sheet (in English);
- Individual letter of recommendation signed by the representative of the relevant faculty (in Georgian);
- Certificate of economic, social or health problem (if available, certificate in English, notarized copy);

Study agreement (see appendix), agreed with the relevant faculty quality assurance service representative.

*Incompletely submitted documents will not be considered!*

More information about the place and time of the interview will be known later.

### **The scholarship includes:**

- Free tuition;
- Monthly stipend;
- Reimbursement of travel expenses.
