



# Tshwane University of Technology - Polytechnic University of Valencia (Spain) Exchange Programs

### TUT-UPV Student Exchange Program

The Tshwane University of Technology (TUT) and the Polytechnic University of Valencia (UPV), Spain agreed to cooperate in academic partnerships under the Erasmus+ KA107 programme. As part of the agreement the two institutions have approved engagement in student exchanges.

#### Who can apply?

Master and Doctorate Degree's Students from the Faculty of Information and Communication Technology (ICT), Department of Informatics.

#### How long is the Program?

The student exchange program is for one semester during the 2022-2023 academic year at UPV. The program will take place from January 2023 to June 2023. Successful candidates will be required to spend a minimum three months at UPV, Spain.

#### Selection criteria

The Selection committee will consider the following criteria in the selection of candidates:

- Postgraduate students (Masters or PhD only) in the Faculty of ICT, Department of Informatics;
- Applicant must have defended their proposal and using design science methodology in their research;
- Approval of project topic by Faculty Research Committee;
- Ethical clearance to conduct the research;
- Acceptance letter to collaborate with UPV, Faculty of Informatics;
- Black and female students will be given priority and
- Applicants must be promising young academics (preferably aged < 45 years), South African citizen will be given priority.

#### **Application Documents:**

The application should include:

- 1. Personal Curriculum Vitae (CV) in English;
- 2. Motivation letter where the applicant expresses the reasons why s/he wishes to participate in this exchange;
- 3. Ethical clearance to conduct the research;
- 4. Progress report/letter (signed by supervisor indicating satisfactory academic performance); and
- 5. Acceptance letter to collaborate with UPV, Faculty of Informatics.

#### **Application Deadline:**

Application should be submitted by email to <u>MotadiCC@tut.ac.za</u> no later than Friday, **16 September 2022.**
