Tshwane University of Technology - Polytechnic University of Valencia (Spain) Exchange Programmes

TUT-UPV Exchange Program Opportunities

The Tshwane University of Technology (TUT) and the Polytechnic University of Valencia (UPV) agreed to cooperate in the exchange of students and staff under the Erasmus+ KA107 programme. The following opportunities are available under the partnership agreement:

1. STAFF MEMBERS AT TUT

Call for the selection of full time TUT Lecturers for a week exchange with the UPV.

Period of stay in the UPV: One week in 2022 or 2023 according to the agreement between the TUT lecturers and the UPV hosting lecturers. The selected lecturers will exchange experiences as well as explore fields of research and collaboration in common.

Eligible TUT lecturers:

- Full time lecturers of the Faculty of ICT Department of Informatics;
- Supervisors and co-supervisors following Design Science Research methodology;
- Acceptance letter to collaborate with UPV;
- Interest to be involved in Bi-literal projects with UPV with the intention to produce research outputs:
- South African citizen will receive priority consideration;
- Blacks and women will receive priority consideration;
- The applicant must be willing to spend minimum of 3 to a maximum of 5 days with UPV, the partner University in Spain.

The application should contain:

- 1. Personal CV in English;
- 2. Motivation letter where the applicant expresses the reasons why he/she wishes to participate in this exchange and defines his/her current field of research;
- 3. Acceptance letter to collaborate with UPV; and
- 4. Draft of a pre-agreed work plan with a UPV professor.

Candidates may be requested to sit for an English Placement Test.

2. STUDENTS AT TUT

Eligible students

Master and Doctorate Degree's students of the Faculty of ICT – Department of Informatics.

Period of stay in the UPV: One semester during the 2022-23 academic year.

Selection criteria

The Selection committee will consider the following criteria in the selection of candidates:

- Faculty of ICT Informatics Departments Post graduates students (Masters or PhD);
- Applicant must have defended their proposal and used design science methodology in their research;
- Approval of project topic by Faculty Research Committee;
- Ethical clearance to conduct the research;
- Acceptance letter to collaborate with UPV, Faculty of Informatics;
- Applicant must be promising young academics (preferably younger than 45 years);
- South African citizen will receive priority consideration;
- Blacks and women will receive priority consideration;
- The applicant must be able to spend a minimum of three or maximum five months at UPV.
