CALL FOR SELECTION OF STUDENTS TO STUDY FOR ONE SEMESTER AT THE UNIVERSITAT POLITÈCNICA DE VALÈNCIA (SPAIN), WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF ERASMUS+ KA107.

University of Cape Town and the Polytechnic University of Valencia (Spain) agreed to cooperate on the exchange of students and staff in the context of the Erasmus+ KA107 program.

To whom: Students of University of Cape Town

Where to: Universitat Politècnica de València (UPV).

Period of the stay in the UPV: 1st January to 30th June 2023

What: The selected students will study between 20 and 30 credit hours in the Schools of the UPV. Doctoral students will carry out a research project at the UPV as part of their doctoral thesis.

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS:

Students from the Faculty of Engineering and the Built Environment (as appropriate according to the academic areas agreed in the Inter-institutional agreement), at Undergraduate, Masters and Ph.D level.

APPLICATIONS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED: BEFORE Tuesday 27 September 2022 to Karen Le Jeune (karen.lejeune@uct.ac.za)

The application should content:

- Academic record.
- Personal CV in English.
- English certificate: B2 or higher
- Motivation letter where the applicant expresses the reasons why he wishes to participate in this exchange.

Doctoral students must present a document that refers to the research to be carried out at the UPV, with the approval of their thesis supervisor and the pre-acceptance of the UPV professor with whom they intend to research during the stay.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Selection Committee will consider the following criteria in the selection of candidates:

1. The GPA (up to 5 points);
2. English Certificate (B2 4 points, C1 4,5 points and C2 5 points);
3. The motivation letter (up to 5 points);
4. Applicant's CV (up to 5 points)
5. The level of Spanish Language demonstrated through the presentation of the certificate of the levels passed in the Short Courses of this language or equivalent accreditation (5 points).
(OPTIONAL)

After the deadline for submitting applications, the list of students admitted to the selection process will be published on the Department of Construction Economics and Management's VULA site (<https://vula.uct.ac.za/x/z4XVBo>) and on the Project website <https://erasmus-ka107.webs.upv.es/calls/calls-incoming/>

The selection committee will meet on 27 September 2022 in order to select the candidates.

The list of candidates with the scores obtained will be published on the Department of Construction Economics and Management's VULA site (<https://vula.uct.ac.za/x/z4XVBo>) and on the Project website <https://erasmus-ka107.webs.upv.es/calls/calls-incoming/>. The candidates will have **two (2) days** to present the claims they deem appropriate to the selection committee.
